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A silver gilt, foil backed flat cut garnet, turquoise and pearl oval pendant, probably Austro-Hungarian, last quarter of the 19th century, the front with scattered scroll and bead motifs within a scroll pierced border, the back fitted with a locket compartment, with a turquoise and garnet set triangular suspension, unmarked, weight 19.1g, length 7.2cm.

Condition Report

517. The hinged door of the locket is very loose and the pin is slightly protruding at the top. The exterior gilding is a bit faded, particular to the back of the locket, which appears to have a lightly brushed finish. Some variation of colour to the turquoise. The loop attached to the main locket is a little bent and has possibly had a lead solder repair in the past. One circular cut garnet is a bit pushed down in its setting.

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
