A George V silver spirit kettle on stand, the half reeded circular kettle with overhead handle above anthemion and egg and dart rim, on a similarly decorated stand with three tapering reeded legs terminating in paw feet, Sheffield 1912 by Walker & Hall, weight 1130g, height 32.5cm, fitted with a later plated burner.

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

355. The kettle is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Hinge is good. Stand in good order but the replacement plated burner has a dent to its edge, one of the fastening pins is bent so removing is difficult. Good clear hallmarks to side of kettle and stand. No inscriptions or erasures.
