A pair of 18th century Irish silver card salvers, each centre with engraved armorial within a piecrust and cast scroll rim, on scroll legs terminating in pad feet, each with scratch weights and initials to underside, Hibernia, Dublin and maker's mark possibly Joseph Walker, weight 509g, diameter 15.5cm.

Condition Report

305. Both in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. One has possibly had a small lead repair to one foot at joint. They are a decent gauge, otherwise typical surface scratches and wear commensurate with age. Slight misshaping to some feet. Engraved armorials fairly crisp. Good clear marks and incised scratch weights.
