A late 19th century German walnut cased upright penny-in-the-slot Polyphon, playing 50cm discs, the case with carved lunette pediment above a glazed door, height 131cm, width 69cm, depth 42cm, together with seventeen discs within a case.

Condition Report

2600. Good working order with both penny slots operating properly. Difficult to see all tips of teeth, but there does not seem to be any missing. Mechanism in need of a clean as it is a bit dirty and greasy. Some overall surface wear, scuffs and marks to edges and corners of case. There are some old woodworm holes to the back boards. The top surface has two holes at the rear where someone had moved the position of the pediment. Otherwise in generally good order. WITH WINDING HANDLE.
