Condition Report

558. The starburst motif was probably originally applied to the front of a Victorian oval pendant locket, now converted for wear as a pendant with the addition of a suspension loop. The diamond looks to be a fairly white stone with one or two inclusions, with one inclusion breaking the surface of the stone. The surrounding half-pearls have an attractive lustre. The emeralds are generally of medium to pale colour saturation. Small chip to the table facet edge of one emerald.

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
