An Edwardian gold and garnet necklace, the front mounted with a row of graduated cushion cut garnets with a pendant row of graduated alternating cushion cut and circular cut garnets, on an oval link neckchain with a cylindrical clasp, weight 13g, length 39.5cm.

### Condition Report

630. There is a hook at the back on the principal drop that would have held a pendant which is now lacking. The circular cut garnet drop at one end is replaced, it does not have a large enough central table facet to match the others. Unmarked, the gold work is of attractive yellow colour but may be over-gilded.
