LOT 683

A gold and cornelian ring, the cut cornered rectangular front with engraved decoration centred by a plain oval cornelian, the shank detailed '15ct' (composite), weight 12.4g, ring size approx O, with a Wartski ring box.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

683. The octagonal top of the ring has a panel attached to either side to block up the original clasp fittings. The collet set oval cornelian is probably a subsequent marriage, which has been attached by lead solder. The associated shank is detailed '15ct', the rest of the gold work has probably been over-gilded to match the shank. There are traces of an inscription to the back of the front. It is also scratched at the two ends where the shank is not attached to remove surplus lead solder.
