A three row necklace of graduated natural saltwater and cultured pearls on a diamond cluster clasp, collet set with the principal cushion shaped diamond within a surround of smaller cushion shaped diamonds, diameter of clasp 1.1cm, length of shortest strand 39cm, diameter of smallest pearl approx 0.2cm, diameter of largest pearl approx 0.7cm.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

783. The pearls are a little off-white and lacking silvery lustre. The pearls are a little more worn at the clasp end. The pearls would benefit from re-stringing. The clasp is rather dirty and would benefit from professional cleaning. The centre diamond looks to be a fairly white clear stone. The surrounding diamonds are well matching to the centre diamond. Central diamond diameter approx 5mm.

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
