LOT 431

A George III silver cruet stand, the circular frame with pierced and engraved sides, fitted with five later glass bottles and stoppers, centred with a turned tapering handle, on claw and ball feet, marks rubbed, height 21cm (some faults), together with three early Victorian silver neck ring sauce labels of narrow rectangular form, engraved 'Anchovy', 'Harvey' and 'Chilli', London 1838 by Samuel Crespel II, ring diameter 4cm.

Condition Report

431. The cruet frame itself is in fairly tired condition with wear and misshaping. Minor lead repairs to uprights. Dents to pierced sides. Repaired central handle. Marks are indistinct and rubbed. Bottles - later with one badly damaged and others with typical chips. The three labels are in generally good order with typical light surface scratches and wear but no significant damage.
