Condition Report

310. Generally fair condition if a little tired and worn. The tortoiseshell has splits/cracks to all four corners, clearly visible in our online images using close-up feature. The silver mounts are in generally good order with typical light surface scratches, minor dents and wear. But no significant damage. Silver inlay all present. Hallmarks are good and clear. Mirror glass in good order. Mahogany back is ok, central panel is slightly warped and the easel stand is a replacement.
