A gold, garnet and freshwater pearl bracelet in a two row design, spaced with small freshwater pearls and five oval cabochon garnets, cased within wirework decoration, on an engraved snap clasp, weight 12g, length 17cm.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

660. Slight bend to the metal aperture for the clasp tongue but the clasp still fastens securely. The seed pearls are a little dirty and have a slightly subdued lustre. One garnet panel is lacking one strand of gold decoration running across the stone. Another garnet panel has had a small repair to one of its gold strands, soldered to the right of its original setting. One panel has possibly had a repair to the connecting chain, from the back you can see a piece of metal protruding from the setting, unlike on the other panels. Would benefit from a clean.

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
