A Chinese Imari export porcelain jug and cover, first half of 18th century, of vertically ribbed baluster form, painted in underglaze blue and gilt and iron red with flowers, height 23cm (restoration to handle and firing cracks).

Condition Report

1288. As per our description, the handle has been broken at the top and bottom and restored with some overpainting, this also carries on to the rim where handle meets body. There are firing cracks to body, the most significant of which runs behind the handle from the rim and vertically down (approx 12cm long). Otherwise, cover in good order and rest of jug in good shape with good vibrant decoration and gilding.
