Condition Report

1734. Heavy wear to the gilding, particularly on the rim. Some losses to the enamel decoration and wear to the high points of the enamels. General scratching and scuffs to the green body. Staining to interior. Heavily worn base rim and a couple of tiny nicks to it. Fundamentally the bowl is in good condition with no major structural damage, but the decoration and body have seen some heavy use.
