Condition Report

1669 - Dancing couple - no significant damage or repairs but there is some small chips and losses to crinoline of both figures.

Figure of fruit seller - broken and missing handle of basket and flaking to paint on black hat.

Lady with baby - broken and missing tip and base of stick held in right hand and minor chips to flowers.

Classical lady - right hand broken and repaired at wrist, head broken off and re-glued, bow broken and re-glued.

Figure of a man - Minor chips to edge of hat and plume to hat missing.

Hide and Seek - good condition, minor wear to enamels and gilt.
