### LOT 530

A gold and diamond five stone ring, mounted with three cushion cut diamonds and two smaller circular cut diamonds, otherwise with rose cut diamond points at intervals, the mount decorated with scroll pierced sides, detailed '18ct', weight 3g, ring size approx M.

Estimate: £650 - £850

### Condition Report

530. Total carat weight approx. 1.00ct. Colour on average approx. H-I. Clarity on average approx. SI2. The three principal diamonds are old cut stones. The two smaller diamonds are likely replacements, with variation of cut to the three principal stones. The diamonds all have one or two inclusions. The principal diamond has a black inclusion near to the surface of the stone. One of the diamonds either side of this has a black pique inclusion. There has been some re-tipping to the claws in the past. Claws to principal diamonds look to be currently sound. The ring has likely to have been re-shanked in the past. The head of the ring is probably Victorian but when viewed from the sides has seen repair work and re-tipping achieved in the past.

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
