A gold and silver set, diamond and enamelled brooch, circa 1900, the front mounted with a cushion and rose cut diamond set flowerhead shaped motif on a red enamelled ground within a white enamelled border, unmarked, weight 7.3g, diameter 1.9cm.

Condition Report

532. There are two small pinholes to the side of the mount, by the hinge and the hook ends. No inscription to the back. The pin has probably been replaced in the past and is only base metal. The principal diamond has a surface reaching inclusion by the sides of the table facet. There is some variation of cut to the surrounding rose cut diamonds. Some of these diamonds have inclusions some of which are surface reaching. The back of the brooch has a small shallow dent at one end of the hinge. One small chip to the white enamelled border. The red enamel is in good condition.

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
