An early 20th century German silver two-handled boat shaped centrepiece basket, the sides decorated in relief and pierced with a floral band above opposing laurel leaf wreathes, surmounted by weapons and a crown, flanked by two eagles supporting a foliate garland, raised on four eagle feet with outswep wings, import mark Chester 1906 by Berthold Müller, weight 753.4g, length 32cm, with a blue glass liner.

330. Generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Possibly a couple of minor repairs to piercing at each end, but this is around each of the seams so could well be in manufacture. Typical light surface scratches and wear. Good clear hallmarks. Glass liner in good condition and fits well.
