An Edwardian silver mounted green flash overlay cut glass globular scent bottle and stopper, London 1904, height 8.7cm, a faceted green glass double ended scent bottle, length 9.7cm, a silver oval trinket box with hinged lid, length 8cm, two silver mounted cut glass dressing table jars, a silver buckle, cast with figures within scroll borders, London 1892 by William Francis Garrud, length 9cm, and a pill box with enamelled lid.

Condition Report

321. Green glass scent bottle - very small chip (approx 1mm) and two surface scratches. Both ends have minor dents and age-related wear. Lacking stopper.

Green flashed globular scent bottle - dent to the top of the silver lid.

Oval trinket box - detached body and needs repair.

Tubular glass dressing table jar - there is a 4cm crack to the rim emanating down into the body.

Pill box - losses to the enamel on the lid.

All items have age-related wear, small marks and surface dents.
