359. All six silver embossed holders in generally good condition with good clear hallmarks, but typical minor misshaping, few small splits to piercing and typical surface wear. 2 porcelain (yellow) liners in good order, 1 with hairline crack and the other with tiny chip to rim.

4 yellow saucers in good order.

All six other silver holders in generally good order, but with typical minor misshaping, typical minor dents, surface scratches and wear. Good clear hallmarks.

4 Aynsley liners in good order with no chips or cracks, typical minor wear to gilt and scratches to blue glaze. The other liner is badly crazed and discoloured.

All 5 saucers in good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light wear and scratches.
