A Tibetan bronze and iron grigug or kartrika (ritual knife), 15th/16th century, the bronze handle with crown surmount, the blade with foliate scroll detailing, length 20.5cm, together with a similar later grigug, 19th century, length 21cm. Provenance: from the estate of a West Sussex collector.

Condition Report

1108. The larger knife has typical wear and is a bit dirty. The blade has some signs of rust and some small dents to edge.

The smaller knife has typical surface wear and scratches. Blade has some rust and minor dents.
