### LOT 1116

A group of Tibetan and South-east Asian hanging adornments and amulets, including two Derge steel and gilt quatrelobed hangings, cast and pierced with dragons, length 7cm, hung with a steel clip, and a carved stone phallic amulet pendant, length 6.6cm. Provenance: from the estate of a West Sussex collector.

Estimate: £100 - £200

### Condition Report

1116. 2 quatrelobed hangings - typical surface wear to gilt decoration and metal. Some signs of rust. The steel clip also with signs of rust.

Steel box - wear to surface, slight misshaping to metal and signs of rust. Coral stones worn and possibly later replacements.

Phallic amulet - wear to surface, otherwise ok.

2 steel implements - both with rust, otherwise ok.

Japanese circular pendant - fairly good condition, typical light wear. Drilled hole for suspension.
