### LOT 1070

A George III silver pair cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, the gilt fusee movement with verge escapement and engraved and scroll pierced balance cock, the backplate detailed 'Geo Hoy, York No15355', the enamelled dial with black Arabic numerals and associated gilt hands, London 1790, together with a gilt metal watch key with engine turned decoration and an associated outer horn veneered pair case, decorated with a rural scene with a figure accompanied by two hunting dogs in the foreground, outer case diameter 6.4cm, inner case diameter 5.2cm.

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### Condition Report

1070. The watch winds smoothly, starts ticking and is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

The dial has hairlines to edge at between 6 & 7 o'clock and a star crack between 3 & 4 o'clock, as well as typical light surface scratches and wear. Glass has typical light surface scratches and wear.

Silver inner case in generally good order with typical light surface scratches and wear. Lead repair to hinge back. Good clear hallmarks.

Outer case in good condition, typical surface scratches and wear. Hinge is good and closes tightly. Good clear matching hallmarks.

The associated outer case is a little big for the pair cased watch, but is otherwise in generally good order with typical surface scratches and wear, but no significant damage or repairs. Hinge is good and closes tightly.

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
