A late 19th century oak Vienna style wall clock with eight day movement striking on a gong, the two piece enamel dial with Roman hour numerals, the case with arched pediment above a glazed door with fluted columns and tapered apron, height 122cm, with pendulum and two weights.

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

1154. Generally good condition, but a bit dusty and dirty. Case in decent order with no significant damage or repairs, just typical scuffs and wear. All glass panels intact. Hinge to door is good, but one of securing catches and hooks is missing. The movement backplate is signed Lenkirch and back of case interior has applied 'Lenkirch' metal plaque. The dial is in good condition. The movement winds smoothly but it does not currently run, maybe a service and some adjustments needed to return to full working order.
