Condition Report

Pair - both in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There are typical light surface scratches overall, nothing untoward or too terrible, and both have some loss/wear to the gilt rims. Other plate - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There is some light wear to the gilding of the cavetto and otherwise overall typical light wear/surface scratches - nothing untoward.
