LOT 1111

A collection of Chinese porcelain, 19th century and later, including a pair of Canton famille rose diminutive vases, height 9.2cm, three Canton famille rose enamelled celadon ground circular dishes, diameters 24.2cm, 19cm and 14.4cm, various blue and white dishes and a famille rose enamelled yellow ground vase and cover, painted with dragons and vapours, height 31.5cm (some faults).

Condition Report

Pair diminutive Canton vases - generally in good order, one with minor nick to underside of rim, both with typical wear to enamels.

3 celadon ground dishes - small example In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration but wear wear to gilt rim and some wear to enamels. The plate with small chip to rim, no cracks or restoration, some surface wear to enamels and glaze. Larger dish with minor nicks to underside of rim, pterwise generally in good order with some surface wear to enamels and scratches to glaze.

Blue and white plate - small chip to rim approx 0.7 by 0.3cm. 2cm hairline at this point. Two other 1.5cm hairlines to rim, typical surface scratches and wear.

Yellow ground vase - the upper section of the body has been broken and re-glued with some associated faint hairlines to the body. Some wear to enamels and typical scratches to glaze. The cover in generally good order. Small figure of buddha generally in good condition with typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels. Figure of lady - head broken off and re-glued, otherwise ok.

Figure with yellow robe - generally in good condition, some wear to decoration.

Other figure of man - generally in good condition, some wear to decoration, including paint loss to black hair. Small pair of vases - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Footed dish - in good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear.

Larger provincial blue and white saucer - generally in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Some wear and scratching to glaze.

Small provincial blue and white saucer - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Typical light surface wear and scratches and some glaze blemishes.

Pair provincial dishes - one with two rim chips, the other with rim chip and 6 small hairlines to rim, both with surface wear/scratches.

Two wood stands - in good condition.
