A Japanese sectional ivory zushi shrine, Meiji/Taisho period, the pagoda top with incised lotus finial above a pair of hinged doors opening to reveal Buddha, on a galleried base, stem and stand, all incised and stained with lotus and chrysanthemum, height 20cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Generally in good condition. One of the down swept corner roof joins is missing the end section - approx 2cm long.

A small section to lower part of stem is chipped and missing. Both handles of doors are missing.

Typical light wear.
