A Japanese lacquer three-case inro, Meiji period, of flattered oval form, decorated in black and gilt with a pavilion in landscape on a matt brown ground, unsigned, length 7.2cm, together with an ivory ojime, carved in relief with a dragon inset with a glass eye, diameter 1.5cm.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

Inro - generally in fair condition but signs of vertical hairlines to lacquer along edges, minor nicks to rims, typical light surface scratches and wear.

Ojime - generally in good condition with natural shrinkage crack.
