A Victorian gold and silver set brooch in the form of a cockerel and wishbone, the cockerel's body mounted with rose cut diamonds and enamelled detailing to the comb, the wishbone mounted with a single seed pearl, unmarked, weight 3.1g, width 4.2cm, together with a Victorian gold brooch in the form of a chick within a circlet, mounted with a single seed pearl, unmarked, weight 3g, diameter 2.3cm.

Estimate: £200 - £250

Condition Report

Cockerel brooch – enamel to the comb of the head is chipped. Three front claws and the back claw to one foot are missing, it has been broken off just below the spur. Damage to the enamel below the beak. Wishbone slightly distorted. The hook of the clasp is slightly bent over.

Chick brooch – very slight rubbing to the high point of the chick's wing, otherwise in good condition. Circlet numbered to the back '14667'.
