A large Wedgwood pottery vase, designed by Paul Costelloe, circa 2000, of tapered cylindrical form with wide flared neck, decorated with two geometric bands beneath a small running fox, height 41.5cm, together with a similar small example by Costelloe, height 26.5cm, and a large cream crackle glazed two-handled vase, height 49cm.

Condition Report

The two Wedgwood vases are in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. The other crackle glazed vase has no factory markings but we would suggest it is a modern 'aged' piece of Italian pottery - it has some minor glaze flaking to the high points.
