Condition Report

3mm long narrow chip to top rim edge of spout with some areas of glaze loss to the top rim edge. There is also a manufacturing blemish to the top gilt rim edge approx 1cm long where the gilding is missing and the body of the jug showing has some black speckling to the paste. Otherwise in good condition overall with no real signs of wear to the other gilding or enamels.
