## LOT 537

An Edwardian gold, sapphire and diamond ring, mounted with a graduated row of three oval cut sapphires alternating with two pairs of circular cut diamonds, detailed '18ct', weight 3.1g, ring size approx Q1/2.

Estimate: £200 - £300

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## Condition Report

Diamonds are single cut stones. They appear bright and white, with a few inclusions, The sapphires are of medium to dark colour saturation. Each stone has some abrasion to the facet edges, with one or two bruises and/or scratches to the tables/facets in places. The centre sapphire has a surface reaching inclusion on the pavilion and chip to the culet edge.

A few inclusions to the sapphires, generally small in nature.

Some slight wear to the sides of the setting and some thinning to the shank. Resized in the past.

Some claws are showing signs of wear which may need re-tipping soon.

Sapphires:

6.0mm x 4.5mm x 2.7mm

5.1mm x 3.6mm x 2.35mm

5.2mm x 3.7mm x 3.2mm

All measurements are approximate and limited by setting.

Diamonds are possibly .03ct each.

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
