## LOT 1485

A Doulton Lambeth stoneware jug, circa 1884, decorated by Hannah Barlow, monogrammed, the ovoid body with a continuous scene of a dog and running cattle, between foliate borders, impressed and incised marks to base, height 18.5cm.

## Condition Report

There is a small puncture hole on one side of the vase directly below the outline of one of the running cattle. Approx. 2.5mm in size. From the interior you can see further chipping/thinning of the stoneware surrounding this hole.

Near this, on the bottom blue foliate border there is a manufacturing firing crack approx. 1.5cm in size. The jug has a reeded top rim and a lip for pouring, it is unlikely to have had a silver mounting. There is no evidence of glue/damage from one having been removed.
