Condition Report

The plaque is in very good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. The enamels and decoration overall are very good with no real wear, although there is some very light wear to the gilding around the edge where it has been handled.

No scratches.

There are the white remains of a previous auction house's lot number sticker which can be seen in the photographs online through the pink ribbon above the left shoulder - these have now been cleanly removed with no damage caused underneath.
