A Dutch Delft charger, late 18th century, painted in blue with a chinoiserie style bird amongst foliage, diameter 33cm, together with a similar figural example, diameter 30cm.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

Bird amidst foliage - approx 4cm long section of chipping to footrim, large area of glaze loss to underside of rim approx 5cm long by 2cm wide with other typical fritting/glaze loss to rim edge.

Figural dish - fritted chip to underside rim edge at 12 o'clock approx 1cm square with small branched glaze haircrack emanating from it, and similar area of glaze loss to underside rim edge approx 4cm long by 1cm wide. Otherwise typical minor fritting to rim edge, one small spot with again glaze haircracks emanating from it.
