A set of four Russian Gardner porcelain circular bowls, late 19th century, made for the Islamic market, decorated to the exterior with gilt edged puce lappet panels, detailed with white flowers and foliage against a similarly decorated blue ground, the rim interior with four Arabic inscriptions in blue enamel, red printed factory marks to bases, two detailed 'N.965' to base, diameter 11cm.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

One has an approx 1cm long firing crack to the top rim edge, otherwise each bowl is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

The inner rim of each is a little roughly finished - a manufacturing issue - and the script to the inner rim of one is a little worn, otherwise gilding and enamels good.

Being sold by a local dealer who has had them in stock some time and is having a clear out.
