A set of six outside factory painted Meissen porcelain plates, late 19th century, with floral bouquets and gilt sprigs beneath gilt rims, cancelled crossed sword marks in underglaze blue, diameter 17.5cm, together with a similar teacup and saucer and a matched Dresden part service, including a teapot and cover and a jug with high scroll handle.

Condition Report

Meissen plates - each in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. The gilt rims display typical wear.

Of the remaining items in the lot one saucer has a number of small chips to the rim edge, and one saucer has a minor nick, otherwise each piece is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
