A Martin Brothers stoneware vase, dated 1874, the high-shouldered body relief decorated and incised with shell motifs edged in scrollwork beneath the extended cylindrical neck with similar decoration, between two mottled green glazed bands, raised on a circular foot with geometric detail, incised 'R W Martin Fulham 5.74' to base, height 20cm (minor restoration to rim).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

Small restored chip to neck rim visible primarily to neck interior because of colour difference, it is approx 1cm long and 1cm deep at its widest points. It is less visible to the neck rim exterior because the colouring here disguises it.

Otherwise the vase is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
