A white gold, platinum and diamond double clip brooch, 1940s, each clip in a swirling design, mounted with two principal circular cut diamonds, otherwise set with baguette and smaller circular cut diamonds, unmarked, weight 34g, total diamond weight approx 8.00-10.00ct, total width 5cm (one circular cut diamond lacking).

Estimate: £2,300 - £2,500

Condition Report

All carat weights and gradings are for guidance only, they are estimations and limited by the jewellery settings. Total diamond weight approx 8.00-10.00ct. Principal diamonds approx SI2 clarity, I/J colour, 0.70ct each. The fronts of the brooch halves are platinum, the back fittings are 9ct white gold. One prong of the fitting to the back is slightly bent out of position. The brooch pin is also slightly bent. One diamond is lacking from the scroll end on the right hand side brooch half.

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
