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A gold, diamond and blue enamelled ring, designed as a rose cut diamond set cross on a blue enamelled ground, detailed '18ct', engraved within the band '17th April 1926', weight 2.4g, ring size approx S (enamel badly chipped).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

It is likely that the ring is of mid-19th century date, now with later inscribed date to the interior of the shank. The underside of the bezel may have had a glazed locket compartment, the frame is now lacking. There are signs of wear under the head of the ring, probably caused by wear from other rings. The shoulders would also have had blue enamelled decoration, this has largely worn away. Significant wear to the blue enamelled decoration. The 18ct mark is stamped twice within the shank this may be of later date than when the ring was originally made. The ring has been sized in the past.

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
