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A 12ct gold, garnet and green gem set ring, mounted with two circular cut garnets between two pear shaped garnets, otherwise set with a green gem to each shoulder, the mount with scrolled decorated sides, weight 1.5g, ring size approx N, with a later heart shaped case.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

There has been a repair to one shoulder which has not been well accomplished, leaving a gap within the setting of one of the green gems. Some minnr splits to the back of the head of the ring.

The ring has been reshanked in the past, the shank is dated Birmingham 1873, the head of the ring possibly pre-dates this.

The green gems are heavily rubbed, it is uncertain whether they are a precious gemstone, i.e. emeralds or just pastes.

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
