A late 19th century French ormolu mounted white marble Marie Antoinette style mantel clock and matching aneroid barometer, the clock with eight day Marti movement striking on a bell, the circular enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals and polychrome flower garlands, the barometer with white enamelled dial, detailed 'EXD by Barwise... London', each lyre shaped case with ormolu sunburst mask and flower garland surmount above acanthus and beaded borders, sunburst and colourless paste set dial surround, on an oval base with rose swags, bead and floral bands, on toupie feet, heights 48cm, with winding key (glazed clock back door cracked).

Condition Report

1205. Both in generally good condition. Both cases a little dusty so would benefit from a clean. Typical light surface scratches and wear to marble and metalwork and some minor scuffs / nicks to edges of marble. Both dials, glass and surrounds in good condition. Clock has cracked glass door to back. Clock movement winds smoothly and runs, and striking mechanism is also working, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Barometer mechanism also working.

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
