A pair of Chamberlains Worcester porcelain plates, circa 1800, painted in sepia with a central landscape view within a rim of gilt ovals edged in gilding, red painted factory mark, diameter 22cm, together with a Tournai porcelain plate, painted in blue with flowers Décor au Ronda, beneath a moulded rim, diameter 21cm.

Condition Report

Pair of plates - both in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, typical light surface scratches to glaze only noticeable on very close inspection, gilding not worn.

Blue and white plate - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Upper surface quite heavily scratched when viewed under a strong light.
