LOT 1710

An Isle of Wight glass Lollipop vase, 1970s, decorated with multicoloured streaks within a clear ground, flame pontil mark to base and applied triangular paper label, height 16.5cm, together with a similar later example with internal green and white colouring, height 15.3cm, applied square gold paper label, and a signed Crizzle bowl, dated 2012, diameter 15cm (internally cracked through base).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

Flame pontil mark vase - there are no cracks, chips or repairs but there is an approx 3cm long horizontal scratch to one side almost halfway up the main body, and a tiny pinhead sized bruise alongside, the bruise only noticeable on close inspection, otherwise there are some typical lighter surface scratches.

Other Lollipop vase - on close inspection a sizeable dense patch of scratches is visible to one side, almost as though the vase has been resting on its side and pushed over a rough surface. Otherwise no cracks, chips or repairs.

Bowl - large crack to base interior.
