An early 20th century Prussian German army officer's dress sword with curved single-edged fullered blade, blade length 79cm, marked for Weyersberg, Kirschbaum & Co, and brass stirrup-shaped hilt with lion mask pommel, with black-painted steel scabbard.

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

3009 - The scabbard is quite rusty but does not have any obvious dents. The blade is straight but is at a slight angle to the handle. The scabbard is 80cm long. The hilt is slightly bent at an angle to the blade and there is slight movement. There is some wear to the grip but all wires are intact.
