## Condition Report

1062. Baluster vase - ' $U$ ' shaped section of rim broken out and reglued (approx $4 \mathrm{~cm} \times 2.3 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) with chips around the break lines. Otherwise ok.
2 ginger jars - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.
Crackled cylinder vase - chips to rim, hairline cracks to rim and repaired section ( $7.3 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
Other cylinder vase - chip to rim and repaired broken out ' $U$ ' shaped section (approx $4.5 \mathrm{~cm} \times 9.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
