A George VI walnut circular cased wall timepiece with eight day single fusee movement, the backplate detailed 'Made by F.W. Elliott Ltd England 1939' and numbered '7009', the 14-inch circular painted dial with black Roman hour numerals and later added crowned RAF monogram with wreath, within a moulded surround, the case back with stamped maker's mark, case diameter 46cm, with pendulum (chips to edge of glass).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1278. Pretty much as it appears in the images on our website.

A little dusty and dirty, but in generally good condition. Case with typical wear, scuffs etc. Two chips to glass edge. Dial has some rust spots visible to front and back. The movement winds smoothly and starts to run, but only for a short period of time (30 seconds-minute) before it stops. Please be aware please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. The pendulum is a little long and touches the trap door when closed, so would suggest pendulum is not original.

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
