A Cartier Paris gold, diamond and black enamelled brooch, designed as a panda, detailed 'Cartier Paris 02511', weight 17.4g, width 2.8cm, with D.S. Lavender purchase receipt, dated '14th December 1998'.

Estimate: £700 - £900

Condition Report

There are a couple of areas of black enamel loss: to the nose, to the front foot and ever so slightly to an ear tip. There is a small area of scuffing to the black enamel on the front arm. Under a 10x loupe there is some general light scratching to the black enamel.

There are various French marks to the piece, largely on the two pins at the back, in addition to the Cartier mark, including the French eagle's head which would suggest the gold is likely 18ct.

The fastening mechanism is in good working order.

The diamonds are attractive white stones, with minimal inclusions when viewed under a 10x loupe.

The piece was purchased by the current owner from D.S. Lavender and comes with the purchase receipt.

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
