## Condition Report

Teapot and cover - some restoration to rim edge of cover, minor fritted nicks to tip of spout, very light wear to enamels. Otherwise in good condition.

Jug - light surface wear/scratches to glaze, otherwise in good condition.

Sucrier - small chip to underside rim edge of cover, floral knob glued back into position and with some small chips to the tips of the petals, minor starcrack to base, very light wear/scratches to enamels.
