A Chinese black silk shawl, 20th century, finely worked in coloured threads with a design of peony, other flowers and leafy stems, $155 \, \text{cm} \times 155 \, \text{cm}$, with tasselled fringe border, together with a Chinese red silk embroidered shawl, decorated with peony, $140 \, \text{cm} \times 113 \, \text{cm}$, with tasselled fringe border.

Condition Report

1078. The black shawl is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Minor unstitching in places, but again nothing too significant. Colours are bright and vibrant to both sides. Black ground is good with no staining. Tassell border in good order.

The red shawl also in generally good order, some creasing and crinkling. Only minor unstitching. Few minor stain spots. Tassell border good.
