A Meissen écuelle, cover and two stands, Academic Dot period, circa 1770, with osier moulding, painted with Deutsche Blumen, flanked by shell and scroll handles enclosing asparagus stems, the cover with seated female knop, underglaze blue crossed swords and dot marks to bases with puce painted dots and impressed numerals, diameter of stands 24cm (faults).

### Condition Report

Cover - small chip to the yellow rose, couple of glaze nicks to dress

Ecuelle - hairline crack to rim, chip to rim above the handle

Stand 1 - chip to interior rim, large chip to exterior rim with hairline crack

Both stands with some rubbing to the gilt decoration and to the decoration on the high points.
